

# YESS 2020 “Moorea Trip” RAFFLE RULES

1. Subject to all applicable laws, including the *Criminal Code* (Canada), the *Gaming and Liquor Act*, the *Gaming and Liquor Regulation (Alberta)*, these Rules govern all aspects of the Raffle Draw. In the event of any inconsistency between the Rules and conditions/explanations appearing on any other document, these Rules shall take precedence.
2. By purchasing a Raffle Ticket, the Ticket Buyer agrees to be bound by these Rules.
3. (YESS) Youth Empowerment & Support Service’s Raffle Ticket License Number is **557136**.

## BUYING RAFFLE TICKETS:

4. This Raffle draw is valid in the province of Alberta only. Ticket sales are restricted within Alberta.
5. Raffle tickets shall not be sold to a natural person under 18 years of age, and ticket sellers must advise ticket buyers that the person whose name appears on the ticket must be 18 years of age or older (due to the requirements of the Public Trustee Act).
6. Ticket sellers shall advise buyers not to write the name of person or person(s) under 18 years of age on ticket.
7. If the prize winner is under 18 years of age, (YESS) Youth Empowerment & Support Services will deliver the prize to the Office of the Public Trustee.
8. The following, including their spouse and any related or dependent person residing in the same household, are prohibited from purchasing a ticket: Youth Empowerment & Support Services (YESS) employees, Board members and Board Committee members.
9. Only one purchaser name may be written on a ticket. In the event a winning ticket stub has more than one name on it, (YESS) Youth Empowerment & Support Services shall award the prize to only the first name identified on the ticket. (YESS) Youth Empowerment & Support Services and the AGLC are not responsible for any disputes that may arise between the different individuals whose names appear on the ticket stub.
10. Raffle Tickets must be paid for by cash, money order, cheque, debit, Visa or Master Card credit cards, and payments are payable to (YESS) Youth Empowerment & Support Services. Ticket sales are final and non-refundable once payment has been confirmed. Cheques will not be accepted as a method of payment after March 31, 2020.
11. Raffle tickets ordered online will be mailed to purchaser via Canada Post after payment is confirmed. Please allow for 10 business days for delivery.

12. Only tickets that have been paid for, and verified as paid for, are eligible for the draw. All inquiries regarding the chances of winning and method of awarding prize can be made to the licensee at 1-780-468-7070.
13. A Ticket Buyer must provide (YESS) Youth Empowerment & Support Services with his or her full name, residential address, and residence telephone number, which becomes part of the Raffle Record. (YESS) Youth Empowerment & Support Services retains the Raffle Record for two (2) years from the draw date and abides by applicable privacy legislation.
14. There are only 150 Raffle Tickets printed and available for sale. There is no minimum number of tickets to be sold.

15. The **online** ticket order deadline is midnight, March 31, 2020.  
The Final ticket sales deadline is 8:30 pm, April 17, 2020.  
The Draw date is April 17, 2020.

### **TICKETS SOLD BY THE 2020 Gala For Youth Event DEADLINE**

16. All tickets sold by 8:30 pm, April 17, 2020, will be eligible for the draw on April 17, 2020. The draw will commence at 9:30 pm at the Edmonton Convention Centre, Hall D, located at 9797 Jasper Avenue, Edmonton, AB T5J 1N1

### **THE DRAW:**

17. The Draw will be for the “Moorea, French Polynesia Luxury Trip” Prize.
18. A random draw for the winning ticket shall be made on April 17, 2020 at the Edmonton Convention Centre, Hall D located at 9797 Jasper Avenue NW, Edmonton, AB T5J 1N9.
19. Two (2) executive members of the (YESS) Youth Empowerment & Support Services, along with three members of the public will be present to witness the draw.
20. The person making the draw cannot have a ticket or an interest in the draw.
21. Draw will be announced to the public on hand and winners will be contacted by phone or Email by (YESS) Youth Empowerment & Support Services as to what they have won and how to claim their prize.
22. Prize draw is performed manually, as required by the licensing body (AGLC).
23. Prize draw will select one (1) winner and that winning ticket is selected from the draw drum at random. After the draw, the winner is recorded, and the ticket number is recorded and retained for the ticket control sheet.

25. In the event that multiple tickets are inadvertently pulled from the draw drum, and this is not identified prior to identifying and reading of the ticket number, the ticket number read aloud, confirmed and recorded is deemed to be the first ticket pulled and therefore established as the valid winner. The draw will only be deemed valid and complete upon final confirmation and recording by two (2) members of the Board of Directors.
26. Draw will be made as stated. An extension of draw dates or cancellation of raffle will only be requested from the Alberta Gaming and Liquor Commission in the unlikely event of a natural disaster or catastrophic event.

#### PRIZE REDEMPTION:
